



TAKING COMMUNITY SKILLS INTO THE CLASSROOM FREE TEACHING ASSISTANT COURSES FOR LAMBETH RESIDENTS

Induction to the course is on Wednesday 01 November 2006 with the course starting on Monday 06 November. After the course, many of the trainees will be able to apply for full or part-time jobs.
